DISTRIBUTION REPORT

- 1. The container arrived Nov.17,20016 and unloaded Nov.24,20016.
- 2. The container was unloaded by the volunteers from Roman Catholic movements, volunteers from Islam Religious, Parables distribution Committee and some church members.
- 3. During and after unloading, there are no items transported to communities/villages. Were presents during the unloading: customs, government delegation, police, and community local leaders and Burundi Parables officers.
- 4. The items were transported by the pastors, community local authorities, leaders from different denominations such as Islam, Christianity and displaced people and refugees leaders.
- 5. The items were given to the schools, hospitals, orphanages, displaced people, refugees from Congo, prisons, street children, women association, pygmy, poorest people in the community etc.....
- 6. To end to distribute the items, it took almost a month and 5 days.
- 7. The items were distributed by 63 people
- 8. The items were distributed in many ways as they were many items:

a/beneficiaries from everywhere were recorded on papers of sheets. The leaders of each group read names listed on a sheep of papers and give items to the beneficiary according to his (her) needs.

b/Sowing machines, tables, school chairs, TV, hospitals beds, hospital mattresses, wheel chairs, keyboards, etc.. were given to the specific projects and proven associations by the committee.

c/Other items were put on the ground and people came to pick up what they want by supervision of the committee.

- 9. Almost a 1000 people were helped including clinics, orphanages, schools and 6 associations.
- 10. The items helped our people so much as there were in a big need of clothes for adults and children. Some repatriated people from Rwanda and DRC are receiving both clothes and kitchen supplies to use as they have nothing. Women associations received more sewing machines to strengthen the capacity of their projects. Some clinics and health centres, their patients were sleeping on the floor mats in the clinics now they received hospital mattress instead of floor mats.
- 11. The container after it was emptied, 10 different Non Profit Organizations have requested it to be used in their cooperative projects such as shops, sewing machine centre, housing, stocking etc..so the committee will sit together and decide which organization will be given the emptied container. I will send you the outcome of the committee or decision taken.
