Introduction:

This report intends to explain the overseas journey of the container sent from Adelaide by the Container of hope. The report shall also include the way how the container was received and also distribution of the items that were sent in the container. We also wish to express the challenges that we faced during the clearance of the container and also during the distribution exercise.

1. The container arrived in Mombasa 29/3/20016 and arrived in Uvira 13/4/2016 and unloaded from 14/4/20016.

2. The container was unloaded by the volunteers from Development Affair of all based on local Area

3. As soon as the container arrived at the customs in Uvira, there was verification of the container to provide the items as they appeared on the packing list. Verification was done. Were presents during the unloading: customs, government delegation, police, and community local leaders.

The items were given to the Orphanages, Churches, local organisation, old people, and people with disability, School, Raped women, widows, and non accompanied children. From (Makobola, Iamba, Lusenda, Swima, Mboko, Kasekezi, Uvira and Kiliba)

The distribution period, it took almost 26 days.

7. The items were distributed by 16 people

8. The items were distributed in many ways as they were many items:

a/ Beneficiaries from everywhere were recorded on papers of sheets. The leaders of each group read names listed on a sheep of papers and give items to the beneficiary according to his (her) needs.

b/ Sewing machines, microscopes, , TV, wheel chairs, keyboards, etc.. were given to the specific projects and proven associations by the committee.

c/ Other items were put on the ground and people came to pick up what they want by supervision of the committee.

9. Almost 819 people were helped including clinics, orphanages, schools and 6 associations. The items helped our people so much as there were in a big need of clothes for adults and children.. Women associations received more sewing machines to strengthen the capacity of their projects. Some clinics and healthcare centres were given microscopes and couple computers.

11. The container after it was emptied is being used as storage for the organisation and used as an office.

Challenges:

Some leaders who managed the distribution exercise did not have cameras so we missed some photos from some villages where the distribution took place.

Many children and adults expected to get shoes but there were fewer shoes then people.
